Abdominal Surgery Recovery. Maintain regular diet but avoid raw vegetables and skins. No exercise or driving for 3 weeks. Take pain medications as needed. Sutures usually need to be removed 2 weeks after surgery. Continue pre operative medications. Schedule postop office appointment 2-3 weeks after surgery. Do not lift more than 15 pounds.
