Table 164.1 lists abnormalities that may be discovered in the musculoskeletal system. If abnormalities are detected in the musculoskeletal examination, there are several questions that the examiner should keep in mind while collecting and recording the data:

### The Musculoskeletal Examination - Clinical Methods

Documentation of a normal neck and back exam should look something along the lines of the following: Neck and back have no deformities, external skin changes, or signs of trauma. Curvature of the cervical, thoracic, and lumbar spine are within normal limits. Bony features of the shoulders and hips are of equal height bilaterally.

CHARTING EXAMPLES FOR PHYSICAL ASSESSMENT SKIN, HAIR AND NAILS Skin pink, warm, dry and elastic. No lesions or excoriations noted. Old appendectomy scar right lower abdomen 4 inches long, thin, and white. Sprinkling of freckles noted across cheeks and nose. Hair brown, shoulder length, clean, shiny. Normal distribution of hair on scalp and perineum.

It's important to note that, well, in real-life documenting a physical exam doesn't always happen exactly as you learned in school. Under pressure to be efficient, most providers abbreviate physical exam documentation to just the necessities.

The simplest form of musculoskeletal screening exam is simply recorded as "gait normal, no focal defects seen". A slightly more detailed examination might include: "No muscular asymmetry noted. No swelling or tenderness of joints. ROM upper and lower extremities normal.

Common causes of back pain include arthritis, prolapsed disc, and muscular injuries.Occasionally it can be the underlying cause of other conditions such as sciatica.. ### Musculoskeletal assessment of general medical in-patients ...

The four recognized levels of history are problem-focused, expanded problem-focused, detailed, and comprehensive (see Table 2A and 2B). Similar to the history component, a few visit categories do not have associated exam levels or documentation requirements for exam elements, such as critical care and discharge day management.

Musculo-Skeletal Examination. Detailed examination of the joints is usually not included in the routine medical examination. However, joint related complaints are rather common, and understanding anatomy and physiology of both normal function and pathologic conditions is critically important when evaluating the symptomatic patient.
